




WHICH BRUSH IS RIGHT FOR YOU?

BRUSH STYLES

	STYLE	DESCRIPTION	USE	HAIR TYPE
	Paddle Brush	Flat and wide	Use to create smooth, straight styles	Long hair
	Cushion Brush	Available in many different sizes and features a cushion that holds the bristles	Use to smooth and detangle; massages the scalp; ideal for wet or dry styling	Medium to long hair
	Vent Brush	Vents or openings in the brushes allow air to flow through, resulting in quicker drying time	Use to create volume while blow-drying or air styling	Any length hair
	Round Brush	Smaller-barrel brushes create curl, whereas larger-barrel brushes straighten and smooth hair	Use to add body and build volume	Any length hair
	Styling Brush	All Purpose Styling brush consists of 5 or 7 rows of nylon pins and boar bristles	Use to create smooth, straight, versatile styles	Any length hair
	Thermal Brush	Hot air from the blow-dryer heats the barrel and allows the hair to set and dry faster	Ideal for blow-dry styling; smoothes and shapes hair	Any length hair
	Ceramic Brush	Ceramic eliminates damaging hot spots, seals the hair's cuticle, and reduces frizz and drying time	Use to create smooth, straight styles while eliminating frizz; ceramic properties are enhanced with blow-dry styling	Any length hair
	Tourmaline Brush	Tourmaline is a natural source of negative ions and far-infrared heat	Use to create moisture-rich hair; properties are enhanced during blow-dry styling; creates smooth and shiny hair	Any length hair
	Massaging Brush	Thick rubberized bristles gently massage and stimulate the scalp for healthy, shiny hair	Distributes styling products evenly throughout the hair	Any length hair

BRISTLE STYLES

	STYLE	DESCRIPTION
	Boar Bristles	Natural bristles that massage the scalp, distribute oils, and close the hair cuticle. Boar bristle brushes smooth fine hair and produce flexible, manageable and shiny hair.
	Porcupine Bristles	Porcupine bristles are boar bristles and one nylon pin per tuft. They easily penetrate thick or curly hair while providing the benefits of boar.
	Nylon Bristles	Synthetic materials that easily penetrate the hair. Molded as firm pins or flexible bristles, they are ideal for thick, wavy or curly hair.
	Ionic Bristles	Synthetic materials that emit negative ions when in use. They help seal and lock moisture into each hair strand, leaving hair shiny, supple, and frizz-free.
